



Button Bag

- **Materials**

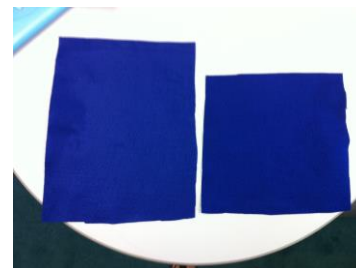
- Sturdy felt
- Thread
- Buttons
- Sewing machine
- needle

- **Process**

- Cut one piece of felt $8 \frac{1}{2} \times 8 \frac{1}{2}$
- Cut on piece of felt $8 \frac{1}{2} \times 11$
- Place the felt together and run a stitch around 3 sides
- Reinforce the end seam
- Sew buttons on top piece of fabric
- Cut slit on bottom piece of fabric

- **Function**

- Place school supplies inside
- Place rewards inside
- Place desired objects
- Use as part of daily fine motor
