Button Bag

Materials

- Sturdy felt
- o Thread
- o Buttons
- o Sewing machine
- o needle

Process

- o Cut one piece of felt $8\frac{1}{2} \times 8\frac{1}{2}$
- o Cut on piece of felt $8\frac{1}{2} \times 11$
- Place the felt together and run a stitch around 3 sides
- o Reinforce the end seam
- o Sew buttons on top piece of fabric
- o Cut slit on bottom piece of fabric

- Place school supplies inside
- o Place rewards inside
- o Place desired objects
- o Use as part of daily fine motor
